

## ART IN LIGHTING

*When the question of lighting this popular Art Gallery was considered, demonstrations were arranged by the Atlas lighting technicians. After tests with fittings and colours the scheme of lighting illustrated was selected.*

To achieve uniform illumination of 15 lumens per square foot on the vertical surfaces, 16 ATLAS FH0080 single 80 watt fittings and four FH2030 twin 30 watt fittings were spaced 8 feet apart, 11 feet from the floor and 7 feet 6 inches from the walls. General lighting of the central area was taken care of by 7 FR0080 translucent fittings hung from the roof beams. The Gallery's lighting was completed with 14 more FR0080 translucent units divided between the Water Colour and Engraver's Galleries.

This lighting scheme was installed by Messrs. A. S. Evans of Camberwell, and planned by the Illuminating Engineering Department of Thorn Electrical Industries Limited.

The Department's engineers are glad to co-operate with architects in the planning of every type of lighting installation.
